At the end of one song Joe continued to sing (in his way) HOLY, HOLY, HOLY is the Lord God almighty. Everyone in the church could understand what Joe had said.

I shared briefly during the service that my son was struggling with some things in his life. Later on we gave the opportunity for people to come forward to stand in the gap for someone else or just for prayer. Joe did not hesitate to move forward, several other people also can forward for prayer.

As we finished the service we all made our way to the back of the church to greet and thank the people who had came out. Joe was just about the last person to come out; as he did he grabbed my hand and said I want to pray for your son. I told him thank you and that I would appreciate the added prayer. Joe told me NO I WANT TO PRAY NOW. Joe took both of my hands and began to pray. The prayer Joe offered was unbelievable. You see I was able to understand every word Joe said, something I was unable to do prior to the service. Joe took his time to pray with me because he saw a need.

When I went into the church that night I had thought to myself I hope we can be a blessing to the Young man in the wheel chair. Little did I know that God had sent Joe to be a blessing to me.
